State Requirements

Local Governing Board

CA Minimum Course Requirements

30 credits in English

20 credits in Math (must include Alg1)

20 credits in Science (including 10 life and 10 physical science)

30 credits in Social Studies (US History, World History, and Gov/Econ)

10 credits in VAPA, World Language **OR** Career Tech Ed

20 credits in Physical Ed (unless exempt)

130 total credits needed

Where is this information coming from?

- REQ Graduation Requirements Table defines required subject areas and credits required for graduation
- CRS Course Table Subject areas, UC/CSU information
- HIS Transcript courses taken, marks, gpa's, class rank calculated
- SEC/MST Classes (Currently enrolled)
- $\circ~$ Academic Plan what's in Grad Status plus what's planned for the future
- Still Needed calculation Credits Required (credits completed + credits planned)
- COD Code Table grad tracks defined, can set up tracks to exclude from class rank or group together for class rank


Multiple Graduation Tracks - Why?

- **O** Different groups may need different requirements
 - Transfer Students
 - Foster Students
 - **o** Career Pathways
 - $\circ~$ Completed Alg 1 pre Grade 9
- Class Rank Calculation
 - $\circ~$ Exempt from Class Rank Calculation
 - $\circ~$ Group together for Class Rank Calculation
- \circ **Process**
 - $\circ~$ Create and set up needed tracks in REQ
 - $\circ~$ Define values in Code Table if needed
 - $\circ~$ Assign students to tracks Grad Status page
 - $\circ~$ Recalculate cumulative gpa's and class rank, if needed Grade Reporting Functions

Mass Update Graduation Status

- Designed to update students' graduation status at the end of the year for CALPADS reporting
- Can be a tool prior to that to track student progress on multiple requirements
- Will track on 4 areas
 - **o** Graduation Requirements
 - Will verify Algebra 1
 - Can includes credits enrolled
 - Can include inactive students
 - Community Service
 - Can verify community service hours from ACT
 - Competency Tests
 - **O** User Defined Requirement
 - Process
 - Set up the form
 - Load the students
 - Preview the summary
 - Preview the students
 - *Reports*



Mass Update Graduation Status - part 2

- End of Year reporting to CALPADS
- Can be run at District or School Level
- Will honor Skip or Keep to update for selected students
- Verify selected options are appropriate
- $\circ~$ Options saved at the District Level will be saved for all schools selected
- When running at the school level, process will only run for the school where user is logged in
- Make certain graduation date is populated
- If Community Service hours are required, select the appropriate ACT codes and make certain hours needed is populated
- If competency tests are required, verify definitions
- If User Defined Requirement is needed, select the appropriate options
 - Example: Career Pathways completer requirement CPW.CM = 1
- Save the Setup
- Load Students
- Review Summary
- Select the appropriate graduation code for each group of students
- Review the Students and make needed individual changes
- Print Verification Report
- Update STU and ENR

College Entrance Requirements

- CRS verify that the Course table is appropriately coded for UC/CSU entrance requirements
- Verify that College Testing has been updated
- View College Entrance Requirements Table for individual students
 - Course Completion Chart
 - Preliminary gpa's
 - Course Completion Status
 - Entrance Status
 - Completer Override students who complete requirements by a means other than high school coursework – example: AP test
- *Run UC/CSU Eligibility Reports format of each matches institution's on-line application*

Graduation/College Readiness Dashboard

- Buttons to calculate graduation status, college entrance requirements, and Add On Grad Requirement
- Will show the last time the update was run
- \circ Can filter by counselor
- \circ **2 Tabs**
 - **o** Graduation Status Summary
 - Will show overall grad status and college entrance summary by grade level
 - **o** Graduation Status Summary by Subject Area
 - Overall summary by subject area and grade
